## Winnemore Digital Humanities Dissertation Fellowship Application

This one-semester fellowship is intended for students whose dissertation engages the intersections between new media and the traditional concerns of the Humanities. If you receive this fellowship, you are agreeing not to accept any other form of financial support from the University or other fellowships of \$2,000 or more during the term for which this fellowship is awarded.

The fellowship stipend is \$7,280, plus full benefits and \$1,000 in travel money to conferences for presenting work from the dissertation. Beyond this application, candidates must provide a 500-1000 word abstract written for a general audience; a statement of work completed to date, work remaining, and expected completion date; a curriculum vitae; and two confidential letters of recommendation, one of which must be from the student's dissertation director.
