Winnemore Dissertation Scholarship Application, Spring 2010

This one-semester fellowship for Spring 2010 is intended for students whose dissertation engages the intersections between new media and the traditional concerns of the Humanities. It will provide a stipend of \$9,570, plus individual health insurance and tuition remission up to five credits. In addition to this application, candidates must provide a 500-1000 word abstract written for a general audience; a statement of work completed to date, work remaining, and expected completion date; a curriculum vitae; and two confidential letters of recommendation, one of which must be from the student's dissertation director.
